- **Absentee voting:** This option is available only to registered voters who meet certain criteria, including residents temporarily living out of state or voters who are unable to vote in person because of an illness or disability.

## ON AMENDMENTS 1 & 2

What's at stake?

- **Amendment 1** represents a power grab by a party with a supermajority whose actions and track records have not always reflected the views and sentiments of the majority of Kentuckians.
- **Amendment 2** would virtually eliminate abortion rights in Kentucky. It would take away a woman's right to choose how she manages her body and restricts reproductive freedom.
- Passage of **Amendment 2** would represent a major intrusion into a woman's personal choice.


